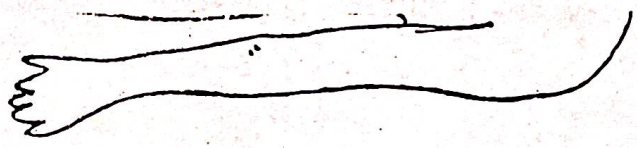

PARTICULARS OF INJURIES, SYMPTOMS, IN CASE OF POISONING

Body of a young male about 25 years of age, about 5'5" tall wearing a kurta and dhoti on legs worn, body is distended. Alleged to have died due to bullet injury. The findings are as follows: -  
 Wounds are 1) 1" x 1" x 1" on the left side of face. Wounds of face are caused by explosion.  
 Injury is on the neck, and caused by explosion. Other organs are healthy though perforation has not yet been done. My opinion is due to shock and hemorrhage caused by the above injury due to explosion which in ordinary course of nature is sufficient to cause death.  
 Time between injury and death is immediate.  
 Time between death and post-mortem was about 72 hrs.
